of the population recognizes the importance of licensure and regulation

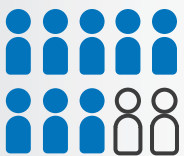
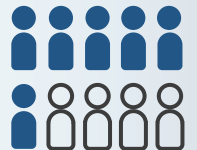
